INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

- 3. Your personal data provided in the Application Form will be processed:
- a) on the basis of art. 6 par.1 b) GDPR in order to make and fulfil an agreement* of which the subject is participation in the Intensive Polish Language and Culture Program organized by the Institute of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners of the Jagiellonian University in Kraków.
- b) on the basis of art. 6 par.1 c) GDPR in order to fulfil the legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator of your personal data in connection with the concluded agreement.
- c) on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 f) GDPR in order to implement the Administrator's legitimate interest in the form of pursuing potential claims or defending against claims connected with the agreement.
- **d) personal data in the form of an image** will be processed on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 a) GDPR. i.e., on the basis of the voluntary consent expressed by you for the Institute's promotional purposes.
- e) within the scope of e-mail address if you give a separate consent to sending information about the programs offered by the Institute, on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 a) GDPR.
- 4. Providing of your personal data described in point 3 a) above is necessary in order to make and fulfil the above-mentioned agreement, i.e., participation in a program. Failure to provide personal data will result in your illegibility for the program.
- 5. Providing personal data described in point 3 d) and point 3 e) above is voluntary.
- 6. Your personal data will be retained for the duration of the program and, after the end of the program, for archiving purposes for the period provided for by law or, to the extent that it is processed on the basis of consent given, until that consent is revoked (unless further retention is a legal obligation).
- 7. You have **the right to:** obtain information about the processing of personal data and rights under the GDPR, to access and rectify your data, as well as the right to delete personal data from the administrator's files (unless further processing is necessary to fulfil legal obligations or to establish, assert or defend claims), and the right to restrict processing, the right to data portability, the right to object to processing in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR.
- 8. Within the scope that the processing is based on your consent, you also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on your consent before its withdrawal. The consequence of withdrawing consent to the processing of personal data will be the cessation of the dissemination your image and the cessation of sending information to the e-mail address indicated by you.

- 9. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making or profiling.
- **10. You have the right to lodge a complaint** with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in Poland (Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych) if you find that that the processing of your personal data violates any of the provisions of the GDPR.
