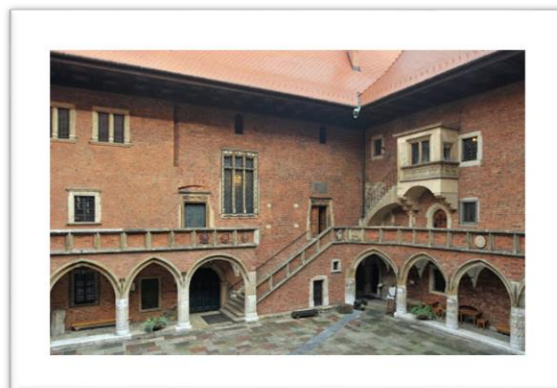


WELCOME
