

INFORMATION ABOUT PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation "GDPR"), the Jagiellonian University advises that:

1. The Controller of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University, at ul. Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of the Jagiellonian University.
2. The Jagiellonian University has appointed the Data Protection Supervisor, ul. Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków, room No. 31. You can contact with the Supervisor via [e-mail](mailto:iod@uj.edu.pl): iod@uj.edu.pl or at the phone number 12 663 12 25.
3. Your personal data provided in the application form will be processed – in order to participate in a non-intensive Polish course for students in the Erasmus program and for foreigners studying at Kraków universities, organized by the Institute of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners of the Jagiellonian University in Kraków in the academic year 2022/2023 pursuant to Art. 6.1, letter b ROD and on the basis of your consent for marketing purposes.
4. If you decide to give your consent, the provision of personal data is voluntary, and in the case of participation in the Program, it stems from law. Failure to provide personal data will result in denial to participate in the Program.
5. Your personal data will be made available to: persons cooperating with the Institute of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners of the Jagiellonian University in order to implement the Program.
6. Your personal data will be stored during the effective term of the Program, and after its completion for archiving purposes for the period provided for by law or until you have withdrawn your consent (marketing purposes)
7. You have the right to: obtain information about the processing of personal data and rights in accordance with the GDPR, access to their data and rectification, and the right to delete personal data from the Controller's files (unless further processing is necessary to comply with the legal obligation or to establish, investigate or defend claims), and the right to limit processing, data transfer, opposition filed against processing – in cases and on the conditions set out in the GDPR.
8. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your data for marketing purposes at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing, which was made on the grounds of consent before its withdrawal. As a consequence of the withdrawal of your consent, you will not be able to receive marketing information regarding the activities of the the Institute of Polish Language and Culture for Foreigners of the Jagiellonian University. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you believe that the processing of your personal data is in breach of GDPR provisions.
